BYLAWS

of the

Village Veterans Club

1. CHARTER

This Club is a department of the Ocean Hills Social Clubs ("Corporation"), a non-profit corporation, which has approved the Club's charter. The provisions of the Charter are incorporated into these Bylaws by this reference. In the event of a conflict between the Charter and these Bylaws, the Charter shall control.

2. PURPOSE

The intended purpose of this Club is A social club to present information and experiences emphasizing veteran interests. The club is open to veterans, and anyone interested in veteran issues.

3. MEMBERS

- Eligibility Residents of Lots within the Ocean Hills Country Club Homeowners
 Association.
- b. Dues Set by the Club's Board of Directors. The amount of Dues will be consistent for all members and will be based on its operating needs and on assessments due the Social Clubs Corporation for its operation, as determined by the Village Veterans Club Board of Directors and the Ocean Hills Social Clubs Board. All monies collected as Dues shall be used only for operating expenses associated with the intended purpose of this Club (as set forth in Article 2 above) and for assessments due to the Social Clubs Corporation for its operations.
- c. Meetings The number of general membership meetings shall be determined by the Club Board of Directors. There must be at least one in-person general membership meeting held in the fourth quarter of the year to elect club officers for the following year.
- d. Voting Any action to be taken by the Club's members shall require approval of at least a majority of Club members present at any meeting where such a vote is held.

4. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Elected Officers The Officers shall consist of: Commander, Vice-Commander, Secretary, and Treasurer.
- b. Directors The number of directors shall be designated by the Club Board and wil be voting members of the Board.
- c. Terms Shall be one (1) year beginning January 1.
- d. Vacancies Unexpired term shall be filled by appointment by the current Club Board of Directors.
- e. e. Meetings Club Board of Directors' meetings will be held as needed. Special meetings may be called at the discretion of the President and / or Board, or if requested by five (5) or more Club Members.

5. OFFICERS' DUTIES

- a. Commander As Chief Executive Officer shall officiate at all meetings and shall attend the "Social Clubs Presidents" meeting, held once a month, or send a representative.
- b. Vice Commander Shall officiate at meetings in the absence of the Commander and perform other duties as directed by the Commander.
- c. Secretary Shall be responsible for minutes of the Club's board and business meetings, and correspondence. Shall have a current list of all members provided by the Treasurer.
- d. Treasurer Shall be responsible for keeping all financial records, filing all necessary financial forms, depositing and keeping account of all funds, and giving reports to the Board and membership as needed. He/She shall maintain a current list of all members.
- e. e. Directors Duties shall be outlined by the Club Board of Directors.

6. NOMINATING COMMITTEE

By June, the President Commander shall appoint a Nominating Committee Chairperson. The chairperson shall select two (2) additional members to serve on this committee. One of the members should be a member of the current Club Board of Directors. The Nominating Committee shall present the proposed slate of officers at a general membership meeting that is held in-person during the fourth quarter of the year, at which time nominations shall be accepted from the floor. Elections shall be held at this meeting with officers to take office January 1 of the following year. There shall be one vote for each office, not cumulative; candidates with the highest number of votes are elected.

7. GOVERNING DOCUMENTS

This Club understands and accepts that the edition of the "Rules and Regulations of

Ocean Hills Social Club's Corporation" most recently approved by the Corporation's Board of Directors constitutes the basic Rules and Regulations governing this Club. Specifically, this Club understands and agrees to abide by the Code of Conduct and the Code enforcement regulations articulated therein.
